DAY 5-8: WRANGELL-ST. ELIAS NATIONAL PARK

This morning, enjoy a hearty breakfast then check out to make your journey to Wrangell-St Elias National Park to check into Ultima Thule! From Stillpoint Lodge, you will board a seaplane for an incredible two-hour flight to the mountain town of McCarthy. See the Wrangell and St. Elias Ranges, two of the largest volcanoes in North America, come into view as you fly over a small part this vast national park. Your pilot will point out various points of interest on this awe-inspiring flight.

On arrival to McCarthy, transfer by private plane to Ultima Thule Lodge, your base for the next four nights. At the lodge, you will meet your adventure guides for an overview of the incredible adventures you can participate to explore Wrangell-St. Elias National Park!

Curious about the array of activities at Ultima Thule? Here is an idea of what you can do:

- **Flight Safaris:** The best way to explore this incredible land is by plane, and that is exactly what you will be doing here at Ultima Thule! With the lodge's private flight safari service, you will be transported over the mountains, landing in the wildest of places including the edges of glaciers, ice fields, and meadows covered with edible berries.
- **Hiking:** Explore the Alpine Tundra and go hiking off trail through fields of tiny wildflowers or, make your way to hike the largest non-polar glacier in the world, Bagley Ice Field. Other hiking adventures might take you to meander with sheep in their natural habitat, or through the spruce, fir and pine trees that make up Alaska's extensive boreal forest.
- **Wildlife Viewing:** Alaska is teeming with wildlife. There are various ways to connect with animals in their natural habitat at Ultima Thule. Here, you can see a variety of birds and marine life and see bears, bison, wild foxes, caribou, even wolves.
- Other activities include salmon and trout fishing, river rafting, year-round downhill glacier sledding, even comfort camping outside of the lodge!
